

# Rockets Launched from Gaza into Israel \*

## 1 January 2001 – 26 June 2018



\* Includes rockets, mortars, and interceptions by the Iron Dome system but not rockets that misfired and landed in the Gaza Strip.

<b>First part of 6-month lull</b> (19/6/08 – 4/11/08)	38	<b>0.3</b> (139 days)	Following several months of indirect contacts between Israel and Hamas via Egyptian mediators, a 6-month lull arrangement (tahadiya) was reached on 17 June 2008.
<b>Second part of lull</b> (5/11/08 – 19/12/08)	336	<b>7.5</b> (45 days)	After IDF preemptive attack inside Gaza on tunnel dug to capture soldiers
<b>After lull officially expired, and before Operation Cast Lead</b> (20/12/08 – 26/12/08)	161	<b>23.0</b> (7 days)	Hamas refused to extend the lull and escalated launches. ... "About 50" Grad (long range) rockets fired between the first Grad launch (28/3/06) and the beginning of Cast Lead (27/12/08)
<b>Operation Cast Lead</b> (27/12/08-18/1/09)	776	<b>33.7</b> (23 days)	
<b>After Cast Lead, 2009</b> (19/1/09 to 31/12/09)	226	<b>0.7</b> (347 days)

<b>2011</b> (except for two periods of escalation)	318	<b>0.9</b> (352 days)	
<b>2011</b> (two periods of escalation)	307	<b>34.1</b> (13 days)	1 <sup>st</sup> escalation: <b>7/4/11-10/4/11</b> . On 7 April 2011, Hamas operatives fired a laser-guided anti-tank missile at an Israeli school bus. From 7-10 April 2011, 65 rockets and 67 mortar shells fell in Israeli territory. Some of the rockets were long-range and fell in the regions of Beersheba, Ashqelon and Ashdod. 2 <sup>nd</sup> escalation: <b>18/8/11-26/8/11</b> . Began on August 18 with the terrorist attack north of Eilat and continued with massive barrages of rockets targeting Israeli population centers in the south. From 18-26 August 2011, 133 rockets and 42 mortar shells fell in Israeli territory.
<b>2012</b> (except for four periods of escalation and Operation Pillar of Defense)	161	<b>0.5</b> (330 days)

<b>2012</b> (four periods of escalation)	551	<b>19.0</b> (29 days)	1 <sup>st</sup> escalation: <b>9/3/12-14/3/12</b> . During the week of March 9 <sup>th</sup> , more than 200 rockets fired and 116 rocket hits identified. The Iron Dome aerial defense system intercepted and destroyed several dozen, preventing hits on populated areas. 2 <sup>nd</sup> escalation: <b>18/6/12-26/6/12</b> . During the six days (6/18-6/23) of attacks a total of 162 rockets fell. 3 <sup>rd</sup> escalation: <b>24/10/12-30/10/12</b> . 105 rockets and an estimated 12 mortar shells hit Israeli territory. The Iron Dome aerial defense system intercepted and destroyed several rockets preventing hits on populated areas. 4 <sup>th</sup> escalation: <b>7/11/12-13/11/12</b> . 121 rockets landed in Israeli territory. Several rockets were intercepted by the Iron Dome aerial defense system (in Ashdod and Beersheba).
<b>Operation Pillar of Defense</b> (14/11/12-20/11/12)	846	<b>120.9</b> (7 days)	During Operation Pillar of Defense more than 1,400 rockets were fired and 845 rocket hits were identified in Israeli territory with about 60 of them hitting populated areas. The Iron Dome aerial defense system intercepted and destroyed more than 400 rockets.
<b>2013</b> (1/1/13-31/12/13)	45	<b>0.1</b> (365 days)	
<b>2014</b> (except for two periods of escalation and Operation Protective Edge)	64	<b>0.2</b> (299 days)	
<b>2014</b> (two periods of escalation before Operation Protective Edge)	320	<b>20.0</b> (16 days)	1 <sup>st</sup> escalation: <b>11/3/14-13/3/14</b> . Fifty rocket hits (most in the western Negev). 2 <sup>nd</sup> escalation: <b>25/6/14-7/7/14</b> . Between June 25 and July 7, prior to the commencement of Operation Protective Edge, approximately 270 rockets hits and dozens of mortar shell hits were identified. Most of the rocket fire targeted the towns and villages near the Gaza Strip and Sderot.
<b>Operation Protective Edge</b> (8/7/14-26/8/14)	3,852	<b>77.0</b> (50 days)	Operation Protective Edge commenced at 1:30 AM on July 8. A total of 3,852 rockets and hundreds of mortar shells were fired. Nine Iron Dome systems throughout Israel intercepted approximately 735 rockets.
<b>2015</b> (1/1/15-31/12/15)	25	<b>0.07</b> (365 days)	
<b>2016</b> (1/1/16-31/12/16)	15	<b>0.04</b> (366 days)	
<b>2017</b> (1/1/17-31/12/17)	36	<b>0.1</b> (365 days)	In addition to 20 rockets from Gaza, nine rockets were fired at Israel from the Sinai Peninsula.
<b>2018 First Five Months</b> 1/1/18-28/5/18	10	<b>0.07</b> (148 days)	
<b>2018 Since 29 May</b> (29/5/18-26/6/18)	204	<b>7.03</b> (29 days)	1 <sup>st</sup> escalation: <b>28/5/14-29/5/18</b> . Barrages of rockets and mortars (more than 150) fired at communities near the Gaza Strip, Sderot, and Ashqelon) – most massive attack since Operation Protective Edge (2014). Many, if not most, were intercepted by the Iron Dome system. 2 <sup>nd</sup> escalation: <b>19/6/18</b> . Another barrage of rockets and mortars (about 45) fired at Israel by Hamas.
